Step 1: Create your Vygo account

Select register/log in with organisation SSO, select Manchester Metropolitan University and enter your login details, then please complete the steps below.

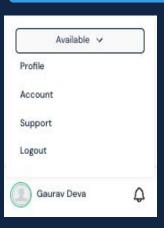

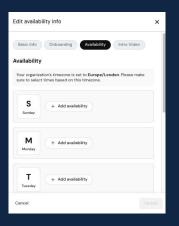


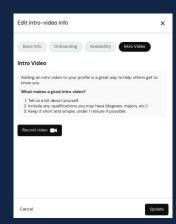
Step 2: Complete your Profile











- Once you've joined the platform, go to the bottom left corner of your screen to edit your profile. Click on the area that displays your name.
- We recommend you complete your profile before joining the programme. Once you have clicked your name, please click profile and you will be able to edit your profile.
 - Feel free to upload a professional photo of yourself as a profile picture, or you can use any placeholder image for your profile picture.
 - Complete your "About me" section, including relevant experience and let your personality come across.
 - Select any languages you speak.
 - o Add in the times that you are available for students to book in sessions with you on Vygo.
- You can edit your profile information or add more details such as an intro video at any point by accessing these settings.
- Feel free to record an intro video so others can learn more about you!

Step 2: Complete your Profile (2/2)

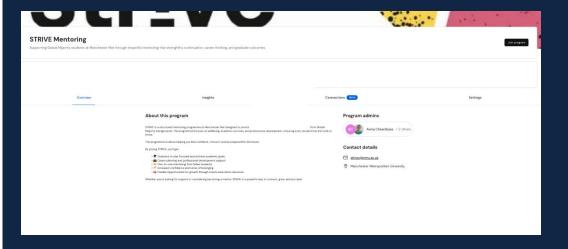


Once completed, your profile will look something like this.

Step 3: Join the Strive Mentoring programme



- Proceed to the programs tab / access the programme from the platform dashboard.
- You should see Strive Mentoring Scheme programme.
- The programme would appear as a recommended programme on your homepage. If not, click the "Programs" tab.
- This will take you into the Overview page. Read the information and click the blue "Join program" button & select 'Join as a member'.

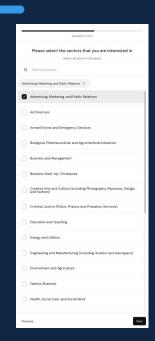
Step 4: Answer the join questions



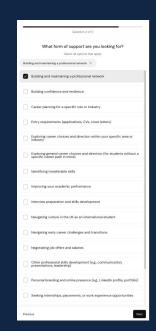
Q1 - Which ethnic group do you consider yourself to be part of

Q3 - Please select the sectors that you are interested in

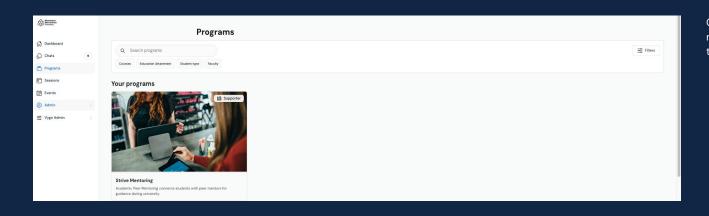


Q4 - What form of support are you looking at?

Step 4: Matching process



Once you've been matched, you will receive a notification by email, and a chat will appear with the mentor or member you've been paired with.

Week commencing 19/11/25

Ensure you follow the steps mentioned to complete your profile.

Your connection to your mentor will be carried out the week commencing 22/11/25 (depending upon mentor and mentees completing setting up their profiles)

Log in and visit your chat page.

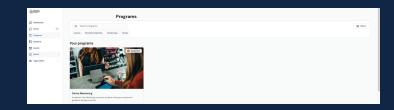
As you are aware of your mentor, you can start booking sessions.

Step 6: Managing your account on Vygo.







Click on your profile area in the bottom left corner to manage your account.

We recommend that you connect your calendar so that unavailable times are blocked out and your booked sessions appear in your usual calendar.

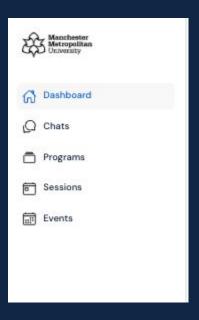
You can also control your email and app push notifications here.

There is an additional availability setting: the "Status" bar on this menu.

If you're busy or away and not able to communicate with your connections, apply this setting, otherwise leave yourself as "Available".

Whenever you log in to Vygo, you will be taken to your Dashboard which has a summary and links of all the relevant information including chats, sessions and events.

Step 7: Communication on Vygo.





View profile Request session

Click on the Chat icon near the top right to see and message with your connections. You'll see a blue dot if you have anything unread.

Flick between chats on the left, view the content in the large chat pane, and write your message in the text box at the bottom.

You can attach files, format text and use emojis, if that's your style!

You can view the profile of your connection in the top right, or click to book in a session whenever you're ready.

Mentors can do the same on their side.

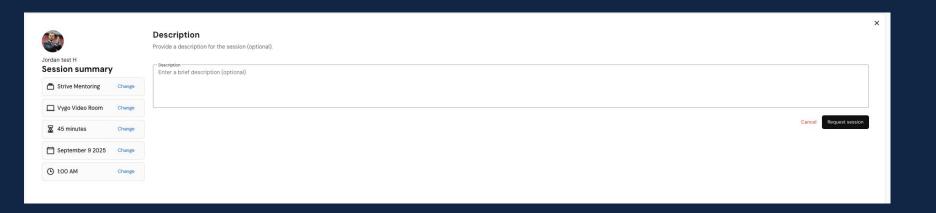
Step 8: Prompt Questions - Your guide to getting the most out of mentoring

This prompt sheet is here to help you get the most out of your mentoring experience. The questions are designed to spark useful conversations, help you reflect on your goals, and make the most of your time with your mentor. There's no pressure to answer everything—just use the prompts that feel helpful to you.

Prompt Questions to Ask Your Mentor

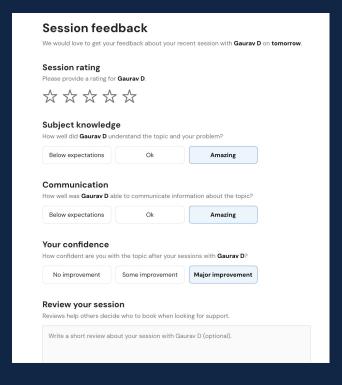
- 1. Are there any skills you wish you had started working on earlier in your career?
- 2. When things get tough, how do you keep yourself motivated and focused?
- 3. Do you have an example of how you dealt with a sudden change in your work?
- 4. What skills do you think have helped you the most so far in your career?
- 5. How do you usually set goals for yourself, and what helps you reach them?
- 6. How did you figure out which job or career path was right for you?
- 7. If you could go back and do something differently in your career, what would it be?
- 8. What was your first job like, and what did you learn from it?
- 9. I'm struggling with my confidence do you have any advice on how I could build it, or something that helped you when you were in the same situation?
- 10. What do you usually do when you're feeling stressed or overwhelmed?

Step 10: Completing Sessions - Feedback.

Members and mentors are required to provide post-session feedback, which is solely used for data collection. These insights help identify areas for improvement and enhance future mentor-member interactions.



- You'll be prompted to mark a session as "Complete" once the time and date has elapsed, and be given a brief feedback form to complete.
- Give the session an overall rating out of 5 Stars.
- Rate your mentor's subject knowledge and communication. Rate your own confidence on the topic of the session and provide comments.

Please note that your ratings and feedback will only be visible to your program administrator and will not be shared with other users.
